The competition is open to residents of The Carolinas, 18 years of age and older. Owners, relatives, and employees of WICKWIRE *fine art/folk art* and the judge are ineligible to enter.

## Judging – By William Jameson



William Jameson is a painter, exhibitor, workshop instructor, and show juror. He expresses his prolific, creative drive this way, "The more I paint, the more I must paint. The *need* is never diminished by having completed a painting, but rather there's an immediate need to begin another."

After studying with Frank Ranpola at Ringling School of Art in Florida, Jameson continued his studies while teaching landscape painting and life drawing as a graduate assistant at the Instituto Allende in San Miguel de Allende in Mexico. Jameson has drawn inspiration from a wide array of work, ranging from drypoint etchings of American landscape artist Chauncey Foster Ryder to the Renaissance masterpieces of Titan giving Jameson a broad perspective.

## Rules of Entry

1. Work must be original and completed without instruction or supervision of any kind and **may not exceed** 48" in any dimension, including frame.
2. Work must be framed (gallery and floating frames acceptable) and ready to exhibit with wire, glass or plexiglass. No "uni-frames." Mats and frames must present a professional appearance with no defects. WICKWIRE *fine art/folk art* reserves the right to refuse any work that is improperly presented.
3. All work must be for sale. Artists will be paid 50% of the retail price with a 50% commission to the gallery. Payment will be received no later than December 19, 2008.
4. Work selected for the show must remain at the gallery for the duration of the show.
5. Artists whose works are not selected for the show will be notified at the completion of jury selection. Work must be picked up at the gallery within one week of notification.
6. Works selected for the show and not sold must be picked up by the artist within one week following the close of the show.

## Conditions

1. I certify that I am the creator of this original piece of art hereby submitted, and that it has been done entirely by me with no supervision or instruction of any other person.
2. I certify that I am a resident of the Carolinas.
3. If selected for the exhibit, I agree to allow my work to remain at WICKWIRE *fine art/folk art* for the duration of the show. If the work is unsold, I agree to pick it up within one week after the show ends.
4. If my work sells, I acknowledge that I will receive 50% of the retail sales price ( see Rules of Entry 3 above).
5. If my work is not selected for the exhibit, I agree to pick up my work within one week after such notification is received.
6. I agree to allow the gallery to photograph and distribute copies of my work to publicize the exhibit.

## Liability

Works are entered at the risk of the artist. WICKWIRE *fine art/folk art* will take every reasonable precaution to protect and preserve the art work submitted. We will not be responsible for any loss or damage to them. Since the work is merely on loan to the Gallery, and still owned by the Artist, insurance coverage is the responsibility of the artist.
